We praise the Lord she departed in dignity and without suffering. After we entered her room, deciding what to do first, we turned her radio on. A few minutes later we heard Amazing grace in English—on secular radio, this was not related to anything what was said before or after. For us this was a touch of amazing peace from heaven. Next week on the 18th we will have memorial service in the Chapel of the Retirement place where she lived. In the meantime we have many things to take care of and our Christmas will be without usual decorating, baking and cooking.
