Both days reveal the same truth: hatred, whether carried out by many or by one, seeks to destroy what it cannot understand or accept. Moreover, both remind us that the answer to hatred — whether global or personal — can never be more hatred.

THE LEGACY OF CHARLIE KIRK

Charlie fearlessly linked today's cultural clashes to the abandonment of Christian values: against secular humanism, he set forth an understanding of man and order rooted in Scripture and in the historical experience of Christian civilization.

Erika Kirk said at his memorial service:
Charlie wanted to save young men, exactly like the one who took his life. On the cross, our Savior said: 'Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.' And to that young man

who took Charlie's life, I forgive him. The answer to hate is not hate. The answer to hate is always love.

The law and earthly justice cannot bring Charlie's life back. In prayer and sorrow, we bear the loss — and with hope, we believe that even the greatest darkness cannot silence his legacy. Only the Christian faith can forgive its persecutors.

Archbishop Dominik Duka was the first public figure in Czechia to draw attention to Charlie Kirk, thus attracting local media attention. His gesture of respect provoked disapproval among progressive commentators, who claimed it was an attempt by Republicans to exploit the tragedy for political purposes. In the local context, they said it was an inappropriate mixing of religion and politics. The controversial memorial service was allegedly attended en masse by far-right extremists. In response to the massive criticism, Duka replied:

Thank you to those who invited me (to serve this liturgy). My only idea on Saturday was to lay this wreath, which remains here, because even in our society, there are people who hate the truth, who lack courage, and who in their cowardice destroy symbols that disturb them. Thank you for having compassion for the family who lost a husband and father. I believe these facts will keep bringing us to the realization that Kirk's struggle for values such as family, kin, nation, and the protection of a child's life are not values to be handed over to a heritage office and put in a museum. They are values we must live. If we abandon them, we will perish.

About a year ago, we experienced a similar tragedy on a university campus in Prague, when a lone gunman murdered several students and then took his own life. It was a moment that shook the nation.
