Our part of the world is even warmer than Florida. Daytime temperatures are just above the freezing point. Spring flowers and cherry trees are blooming. Some birds did not migrate southward. Actually, we do not have snow on the ground yet. Believe it or not some days are even sunny. We pray that the weather will last at least another week through the weekend of January 25th, to have good driving conditions for our conference in Brno.

This month it is our 25th anniversary since we started publishing our magazine "The Battle for the Soul. To tell the truth, we look back and marvel how faithful He is in providing everything needed for this ministry. From time to time we call the fruits of our labor "mini-revival" as we are receiving e-mail messages from thankful readers who find the magazine a great source of teaching and information. They share their heart with us and often say that they found most of the answers in our magazine to be reassured that they are not sectarians. By now we have over 3,000 texts and audios accessible through Internet. It's some 120 files a year or, we upload an article, brochure, book or audio file every third day. We are so thankful for our young coworkers who are taking our load onto their shoulders. They are and will carry on the ministry we started.

Our hearts are overjoyed by the variety of fruit we taste. Klara, as she is translating sermons of Steve Cole from Flagstaff, thrives by the nourishment coming from Steve's ministry. Quite a bit of time transpires between the translating and editing until finally listening to produced programs on Radio Logos, Slovakia or TWR. To listen to the final product is like tasting fresh and ripe fruit served on the silver plate. Once again we are praising the Lord for Milan in Slovakia who is at the end of production. His most recent message reads as follows: "At the present time I am in the middle of major studio reconstruction to be able to handle live broadcasting. After it is done I will mail you at least a photo." Milan is a remarkable Saint. I think he will get one of the largest crowns in heaven. Please pray with us that the Lord will provide volunteers to help him.

January is the perfect time for winter cultural events. As you know, Pavel is a big band and swing enthusiast. It is almost tradition that we attend the Glenn Miller orchestra performing in Prague each winter. Another interesting exhibition Klara enjoyed was about the money phenomenon in broader context. One part of the exhibition is called "To the End of the World for Money", next is "Money Makes the World Go Around," and the third "Popularity that Money Can Buy." On the display were treasures of the National Museum, jewelry, the largest diamond in Czech collection, and the gold hundred-ducat coin of Emperor Ferdinand III, one of the six such coins known worldwide. A highlight for Klara was to lift up a 24 pound gold brick on the display. It is very weird to lift up such a small but heavy object. By the way, the monetary value of this specimen is almost half a million dollars! What a concentration of wealth.
