Below is the full picture of what the Lord is doing in answer to your prayers for us.

In our February EPPR email we mentioned the following short message:

FEBRUARY is usually the Valentine month. However, several small events led us to a decision to take one month of Rest and Recreation. Before we left home we prepared our electronic Prayer and Praise Report with the idea that we would email it during our R&R.

As it happened, we did not have the file on our flash stick, so here is the full report about recent exciting news in the ministry.

January 22, 2011 was culmination of a year long planning and preparation of the 2nd Theological Conference in Brno. The topic was: Sola Scriptura, Sola Gratia, Solus Christus, Sola Fide and Soli Deo Gloria. The location of the conference is worth men-It was established by the tioning. Weslevan Church from the USA. The portrait of Mr.&Mrs. Evan who sacrificially financed this complex is there, so we know to whom to say -"thank you." The place was full to its capacity as the attendance tripled compared to last year. We had 156 people who took part in this endeavor. They came from the most eastern reaches of Slovakia to the most western part of Czech Republic. Those attending were of many denominational backgrounds. It was a special time for us, since we met in person several readers and listeners we have known by name for decades. With tender emotions we listened to many stories about how people became readers and listeners, and how they found out about our ministry. Right there we met our first administrative helper, our first employees, our first magazine distributors. We also met young men who became pastors. We got several invitations to minister in different places and churches. What a joy to have so many friends and partners in both countries.

There were five different speakers at the conference. One of the Solas was presented by a "well seasoned US missionary" who started serving here during the communist era.

The days before the conference were very hectic and it was amazing how timely everything worked out. A pocket theology booklet titled "What is evangelical?" by Dr. Martyn Lloyd Jones for the conference attendees was delivered by printers to our house on Thursday as we were ready to drive to Brno. On Friday Pavel recorded another batch of programs for Trans World Radio. Saturday was the conference D-day. During the conference our publishing team sold a number of books and the book "Comenius" was in great demand.

The Conference was recorded and many more people will listen to it. We will also provide written content of the conference. The next conference is already planned for January 21, 2012. Its topic: Exaltation of Christ.

As we mentioned in our last Prayer letter, two more radio frequencies were assigned to TWR (Radio 7) in Slovakia. Hardware equipment for one Radio station costs about \$30,000. David Uhles, HCJB Global director for this region, is coming in March and with Pavel will visit three locations (Brno, Bratislava and Banská Bystrica). It looks like a big challenge. But, on the other hand, we get a great encouragement from listeners who keep us moving ahead. Within one year of starting, Banská Bystrica, the first FM Radio 7 station, is now rated as the most-listened-to station with the number of listeners around 10,000. can see the difference in impact between Internet, Satellite and FM broadcasting. FM is far more effective.
