DEAR FRIENDS AND PARTNERS OF THE REACH BEYOND MINISTRY TO THE PEOPLES IN CZECHIA AND SLOVAKIA

This is our second printed Prayer and Praise Report this year. It looks like April is almost over. We know it is better three hours too soon than a minute too late. So here we are, catching up after Easter. So, here is our report:

Since we are thorough believers in the Holy Scriptures, we had a lovely Good Friday service followed with lamb dinner, Resurrection Sunday service and on Easter Monday we joined the partner church in about 5 miles hike. The weather was getting from Friday to Monday cooler and cooler, and on Monday it rained. We got back on asphalt road with heavy mud balls on our shoes. As we drove back home the weather cleared and it was sunny.

The Easter Week in the Czech Catholic tradition that is heavily mixed with pagan spring celebrations starts with: Blue Monday, Gray Tuesday, and Ugly Wednesday. Since now on it gets better: Green Thursday, Good (Great) Friday, followed by White Saturday, Easter (Resurrection) Sunday, and is topped by Easter Monday.

The Easter Monday is a merry holiday with typical pagan connotations celebrating fertileness and rejuvenation. Men and boys visit the home of girls they like or have crush on. They whisk girls' legs and behinds with an Easter pomlázka (from pomladit or "make younger"). It is a braided whip made from pussywillow twigs. It has been used for centuries by boys who go caroling on Easter Monday and symbolically whip girls on the legs. The girls give them in return dyed hard-boiled decorated eggs, chocolate baby animals like lambs, bunny rabbits, and chickens. Adults prefer shot of alcohol. The more boys that come to whip a girl the more honored or desired she is; and she truly enjoys it.

Dousing a girl with water has a similar symbolic meaning as the *pomlázka*. When Klara was a young girl her father kept the boys from the door by spurting them with gardener hose.

In the past, *pomlázka* was also used by the farmer's wife to whip the livestock and everyone in the household, including men and children.

It all symbolizes spring procreation, rejuvenation thus new young life in general. To get more on the subject open the following page:

After watching the previous video from Slovakia we have to tell a story. Pavel's mother was Slovak and was born on Easter Monday. In those days (1915) practically every child was born home with midwife assistance only. Her father went to vicarage to record her birth. However, on the way there was so much whipping and dousing commotion and spirits shots (celebrating birth of his daughter on top of Easter Monday craziness) that he got under an impression the recording to register went as it should. When Pavel's mother was to present the first time in her life birth certificate, when marrying (1936), she found out she has not been officially existed for 21

years. At least she could change her name from Ilona to Helena.
