In 1986 our family lived first year in Australia, as we illegally left communist Czechoslovakia with three children. I was 50 years old chemist, my wife 9 years younger medical doctor. I heard about Pavel Steiger book The Battle for Soul in Czech language published in Canada. I ordered book and red it with one breath. I praised the book to my wife and the same evening she opened the book. First look lasted all night. With Bible in her hands unbelieving happened. Next morning tired wife embraced me with words: "after reading the book from Canada and checking references in the Bible she exclaimed "I believe in God of the Bible." This was 32 years ago and we walk together in faith.

The great Christmas gift is coming. Next Tuesday we will meet with this couple in our place. They returned to Czech Republic and now live in Brno. We will spend a day together.

This story reminds us of an old listener to our radio programs and reader of the magazine we publish. She was 94 about 20 years ago when she had a special Christmas wish—to meet us in person. Her children, much older than us, living in Germany, brought (carried) her over. What a joy; what a remembrance!

THANKSGIVING

Dr. Peter Hammond from Frontline Fellowship in South Africa recently shared a few thoughts on Thanksgiving that we translated for our magazine. There is a couple of paragraphs below:

Taking God's Blessings for Granted

Dr. Martin Luther observed that we exhibit a degree of thankfulness in life in reverse proportion to the amount of blessing we have received. In Tabletalk, Dr. Martin Luther wrote: "The greater God's gifts and works, the less they are regarded." The blessings of life, health, freedom and food are not really appreciated unless they are lost, or threatened. Because sunrises and sunsets occur daily, they are taken for granted.

A Biblical Command

There are at least 138 passages of Scripture that deal with the subject of thanksgiving. We are commanded: "Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise; give thanks to Him and praise His Name." (Ps 100:4)

PRAYER NEEDS

 Please pray for the church in Czech Republic. In November five churches declared independence from the Brethren Baptist Union. Paul Washer described the situation of the European churches as follows:

I can say with confidence that there is more light of the gospel in jungles of the world than in the very churches of Europe where some of the greatest preachers in the history of Christianity once preached."

Europe is losing its identity. European Union is creating more and more declarations and regulations, which makes Christianity very vulnerable. Another issue is the Istanbul Convention to counter domestic violence and implement concept of "gender" - female and male, but the "socially fixed roles, behavior, activities and characteristic that a certain society considers appropriate for a woman and a man". Half of the European countries signed the Istanbul Convention. Gender "antidiscrimination" agenda is so far reaching that our civilization is being transformed in front of our eyes. With remnants of believers, we face two enemies godlessness of people and far reaching political and social experiments of our days.

- Pray for the Czech Church so it may teach Christ and only Christ.
- Pavel is working on another book: "They Shall Reign with Him a Thousand Years."
