SEPTEMBER 2020 DEAR FRIENDS AND PARTNERS OF THE REACH BEYOND MINISTRY TO THE PEOPLES OF CZECHIA AND SLOVAKIA

Fall is almost here and we would like to say that our days are returning to normal. A better description of the present time is that we do not know what normal is. As we mentioned in our last Electronic Prayer Letter, summer despite coronavirus was time for most people to take a vacation. Locals as well as neigh-



boring European tourists did. We became Prague tourists. Nothing unusual or critical was happening. However, now the testing frenzy has taken off. Suddenly the country, especially Prague, is back on red alert. Travel in and out is once again restricted. Face masks in closed areas are again compulsory. There is some confusion about schools; some are open, some closed. Cultural events are on, some sports events are limited or without spectators, restaurants and pubs have to close by 10 p.m., no new church gathering regulations are issued, ... The sky is clear, no airplane streak across the sky is visible.

SLOVAKIA TRIP AND RADIO LOGOS

Usually, the end of summer has lovely weather so we decided to take a minivacation. In spring we signed up for a conference with D. A. Carson in Poprad, Slovakia which was canceled due to the coronavirus travel restriction. The hotel prepay was not refundable but extended until the end of this year. We took a train to the majestic Slovak High Tatra mountains with 29 peaks over 8000 feet high scattered over 16 miles long and about 10 miles wide range. No wonder they are called the smallest mountain range. To get to the top of Lomnický Peak 8642 ft., the second-highest peak, we had to take three independent cable car sections. The last one hangs 300 ft. above the ground. The cable is 6129 ft. long and ascends 2835 ft. In 1940 it was the longest free-hanging cable car with no support tower. Most amazing is that this segment of red cabin ride opened in 1940 and used to be the most modern cable car in Europe.

The UNESCO Wooden articular church in Kežmarok was built by the local Lutherans in 1593 during a period of religious persecution.

DID YOU KNOW? The Discoverer of A, B, AB, and 0 Blood Groups?

Jan Janský, born in Černošice near Prague in 1873, graduated from the Medicine Faculty of the Carolina University of Prague, specializing in Neurology and Psychiatry.

Dr. Jan Janský dedicated himself to the investigations of the laboratory, to clarify a relationship between mental upheavals and the composition of the blood. He analyzed more than three thousand samples of the blood of its patients.

The doctor wanted to find out if the serum of the psychotic patients, especially the schizophrenic, differs by its coagulation characteristics from that of normal people. Interestingly, this was proved with more sophisticated methods almost a century later. With the coagulation of the blood, Dr. Jan Janský established in 1907 four blood groups that nowadays we call A, B, AB, and 0.

His discovery made it possible to do transfusions without endangering the patient's life by receiving blood from an incompatible donor.

Dr. Janský published his discovery in the work entitled "Hematological Studies in Mental Patients". In 1921 the American Medical Association accepted the definition of the blood groups established by Dr. Janský.

Dr. Jan Janský passed away from cardiac disease before turning 50 years of age, as a result of ailments undergone in the trenches of World War I. Janský knew in life neither glory nor great honors and is only now being recognized as the true discoverer of the blood groups.
