Even simple advice, such as gradually increasing physical exertion, proper hydration, the need for more protein intake, and at the same time fighting off appetite and upset stomach, takes the utmost of one's remaining strength.

Last year ended with an unusual numerical sequence, the date 12. 31. 23 resembles the marching pace of 1,2,3 - 1,2,3 as we enter the New Year with the hope of another year of activities, new events and expectations.

After the New Year, we learned that Emily, now the fiancée of our grandson Samuel (23), had said yes. It is only because of God's protection that the health crisis happened when we were at home, that we have one of the best hospitals just a few minutes away from our home, that the doctors prevented the worst from happening, the treatment with antibiotics with such unpleasant side effects... Many prayers strengthened us and reminded us that we are not alone in going through such trials. The idea of the hardships that patients go through during cancer treatment, after major surgery, all lead to a deeper prayerful connection, compassion, and gratitude that our problems are relative.
